

Contest Rules:

1. The contest is open to amateur photographers (those who make less than 50% of their income from photography). Each participant may enter *one photo per category*. **Printed photos will not be returned.**
2. **Pictures do not have to be taken with a camera;** pictures from phones and other devices are eligible.
3. **For print submissions:** Black-and-white prints, color prints, and prints from digital photos are accepted. Photos should be at least **3x5"** but no larger than **8x10"** and should not be matted or framed. **For emailed submissions:** black-and-white or color pictures; file size under 10MB.
4. A completed entry form, or text with required information if emailing from a phone or other device, must accompany each photograph submitted. Incomplete entries will not be considered. **Include: your name, address, phone number, category for entry, and age group.**
5. **Print submissions** may be

dropped off at, or mailed to, the Clark County SWCD office, 9608 Highway 62, Charlestown, IN, 47111. **Email submissions** should be sent to melanie.davis@in.nacdnet.net.

6. All entries must be received by close of business **June 28, 2019.**

One winner will be selected in each of the four categories. Winners will be notified on or before **July 10, 2019.**

All winners will receive a gift certificate, as well as recognition in the District newsletter and website. Winning photos will be displayed during the Clark County 4-H Fair in the SWCD's Natural Resources Conservation Education Area.



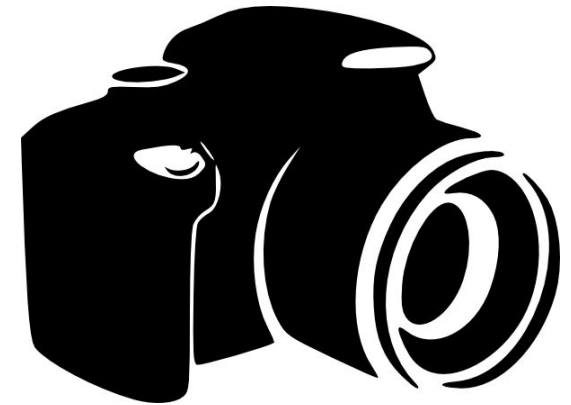

Sharp and clear—center of interest should be sharp and clear (though not everything in the photo must be sharp).
